CARE AND CLEANING INFORMATION

PROCEDURES

Dust your furniture with a dry cloth regularly. Damp dust occasionally with Murphy's Oil Soap or Scratch Guard (use as recommended). Other mild cleaners such as Formula 409 and Mr. Clean can also be used.

Black For best cleaning and non-streak shining of Black **laminate**, use Countertop Magic or Panel Magic, found most often in hardware stores. Spray on a cloth and then use the cloth to wipe the unit.

Techline surfaces resist most spills. However, special cleaners may be necessary for specific stains. It is important to clean any stain soon as possible.

<u>Chemical Stains</u> – Exercise care when using bleaches, dyes or concentrated detergents near laminate surfaces. Never use oven cleaners, bowl cleaners, or rust removers on your furniture. If these products do come in contact with surface, rinse with water immediately.

<u>Rubber Scuffs</u> – Cleaners with ammonia or solvents such as denatured alcohol, fingernail polish remover, or paint thinner may be required. Rinse well with water.

<u>Abrasives</u> – Avoid liquid abrasive cleaners they may damage your surfaces. Powder cleansers and scouring pads should not be used because they will dull or scratch the **laminate** and make it more susceptible to staining.

<u>ADDITIONAL CARE INFORMATION</u> Avoid conditions involving standing water or other liquids that would expose edges and seams to prolonged contact to liquid. Extremely hot items should not be placed on the surface as permanent damage may occur.

MOVING PROCEDURES Avoid dragging or tipping units to prevent needless strain. For long distance moving, carefully remove connectors joining units together. Remove door and drawer pulls and secure inside one of the units. Tape all doors and drawers closed. If a hand truck dolly is used, sufficiently pad the surface in contact with the unit. Minor breakage may be repaired with white glue and clamps. Techline provides breakdown and packaging for shipment, design work for relocations, reconfiguring hauling and re-installation.
